



## WHAT IS A GUARDIAN and WHO QUALIFIES

Western ND Honor Flight allows Veterans to request a personal Guardian to accompany them on the trip **only when assistance is required** for specific mobility or medical needs.

Guardians must be physically capable of assisting the Veteran throughout the journey, including tasks such as handling carry-on luggage, assisting with wheelchairs, and understanding the Veteran's medical conditions, medications, and care requirements.

In accordance with Western ND Honor Flight guidelines, spouses, significant others, partners, and fiancées are not eligible to serve as Guardians. These trips are dedicated to honoring Veterans, and limited space and resources must remain focused on serving as many Veterans as possible. In addition, experience has shown that the camaraderie and shared experiences among fellow Veterans can be meaningful and healing.

To ensure every Veteran receives the support they need, Western ND Honor Flight provides Honor Flight volunteers and medical staff who are available throughout the trip to assist with additional care and support.
